Professional Education Programme 2019 Approved for 14 Clinical Diagnostic Credits

Glaucoma NZ invites you to enrol in the GNZ Professional Education Programme for 2019.


An online web-based course structure:

- The professional education programme is approved by the NZ Optometrists & Dispensing Opticians Board (ODOB) CPD Accreditation Committee for a maximum of **14 Clinical Diagnostic (CD) Credits. Or for registered Glaucoma Prescribers this will be 12 Clinical Diagnostic (CD) Credits plus 2 Glaucoma Education (GE) Credits.**
- All cases have been produced by qualified glaucoma specialists.
- The Programme consists of 7 new cases each year – each with a case history, questions and answers for self-directed learning, followed by an associated web-based examination.
- The examination associated with each case is made up of 25 questions – multiple choice and true/false.
- Two attempts are available to achieve the 70% pass required by the ODOB CPD Accreditation Committee.
- Each successfully passed case attracts 2 CD credits as approved by the ODOB CPD Accreditation Committee.
- Successfully passing all 7 cases awards the maximum of 14 CD credits.
- CD credits are only allocated to each case completed before midnight Monday 30th September 2019.
- Enrolments will close midnight on Wednesday 25th September 2019. The programme will close at midnight Monday 30th September.
- Examination answers will be available for review from 1st October 2019 until 30th November 2019.
- The enrolment fee is \$285 (incl GST) *i.e.* for up to 7 cases.
