Glaucoma New Zealand Statement of Accounting Policies

For the year ended 31 March 2022

Basis of Preparation

Glaucoma New Zealand has elected to apply Tier 3 PBE SFR-A (NFP) Public Benefit Entity Simple Format Reporting - Accrual (Not-For-Profit) on the basis that it does not have public accountability and normally has total annual expenses of equal to or less than \$2,000,000. In the year ending 31 March 2021, an unusual bequest income and related expense increased expenses to over \$2,000,000, but this is not the normal pattern of expenses. The Tier 3 standard allows Glaucome New Zealand to continue to use Tier 3 reporting in this circumstance. All transactions in the Performance Report are reported using the accrual basis of accounting. The Performance Report is prepared under the assumption that the entity will continue to operate in the foreseeable future.

Goods and Services Tax (GST)

All amounts are recorded exclusive of GST, except for Debtors and Creditors which are stated inclusive of GST.

Income Tax

Glaucoma New Zealand is wholly exempt from New Zealand income tax having fully complied with all statutory conditions for these exemptions.

Bank Accounts and Cash

Bank accounts and cash in the Statement of Cash Flows comprise cash balances and bank balances (including short term deposits) with original maturities of 90 days or less.
